Dear Leadership Waco Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in **Leadership Waco**. The Greater Waco Chamber of Commerce conducts this program to identify potential community leaders and provide these individuals with information about various facets of our community, which improves the quality of life of area residents.

Solutions to community needs demand the active participation of informed citizens. **Leadership Waco** offers structured learning opportunities in an atmosphere that stimulates creative thinking and encourages participants to work together to utilize both new and proven tools to meet the challenges of today and to prepare for tomorrow.

Upon the successful completion of the **Leadership Waco** program, graduates enter a resource pool available to various civic, cultural and service organizations in the Waco area.

A limited number of participants will be selected for enrollment in the 2020-2021 class of **Leadership Waco**. Completion of the enclosed application is an important part of the selection process. Each application will be reviewed by an anonymous selection committee. Final approval of the Leadership Waco class will be given by the Chambers Executive Committee. **Leadership Waco** participants will be publicly announced in July.

In order to qualify, an applicant must be at least 25 years of age and either have lived or worked within the city of Waco or its extraterritorial jurisdiction for the past 12 months.

As with all worthwhile endeavors, **Leadership Waco** requires a definite commitment of time from each member. The program will begin with a one-day retreat in August at the Baylor Ropes Course, followed by nine class sessions held on the third Tuesday, September through May; attendance is required at a minimum of one City Council, School Board or County Commissioners Meeting and attendance at a minimum of one local cultural event (theater, symphony, art exhibit) and a group service project. Attendance at each session is essential, and participants missing more than two sessions will be dropped from the program. Additionally, we are requesting Leadership Waco's participation in our Total Resource Campaign (TRC). Our campaign is an all-volunteer effort to enlist new members, generate program, publication and event sponsorships, secure budget reduction items and raise awareness of the Chamber throughout the region. Leadership Waco participants will be encouraged to create a team, set a fundraising goal and work towards reaching that goal.

A fee of \$1,200 must be paid for each participant. This fee helps cover costs of the program, including materials, meals, transportation and any other related expenses. The applicant must pay \$100 of the fee. The balance may be paid by the participant, an employer or a sponsor. Your completed application, along with the signed statement of commitment and a photograph/headshot, must be received by the Greater Waco Chamber of Commerce office or be postmarked **no later than the extended deadline: Monday, June 15**. Program tuition is \$1,225 and helps cover the cost of the program. Including meals, materials, transportation and any other related expenses. The \$25 is a non-refundable application fee that should
accompany the application at the time of submittal. The applicant must pay \$100 of the remaining
\$1,200; the balance may be paid by the participant, an employer or a sponsor
Tuition is not due until you have been notified of your selection into the class, at which point full
tuition will be due by the retreat in August.
Orientation is a mandatory full-day retreat in August 2019. (Tentative date is Tuesday, August 18 th) Participants are expected to attend each of the ten sessions (August-May). All sessions are from
8:00am to 5:00pm and typically take place on the 3 rd Tuesday of every month (Dec. and May are 2 nd
Tuesday) (breakfast and lunch included).
A maximum of only 2 absences are allowed per year. Leaving early (more than 2 hours) and arriving
late will (more than 2 hours) count as an absence.
Participants are expected to arrive on time and stay for the entire day.
Participants are expected to silence cell phones during the session and wait to conduct their business
during breaks, on the bus or at lunch when there is no scheduled programming.
Handheld devices and tablets may only be used for taking notes during the sessions.

 Complete all outside assignments, including but not limited to the following: Attendance at a minimum of one City Council, School Board or County Commissioners meeting Attendance at a minimum of one local cultural event (theater, symphony, art exhibit, etc.) Participation in the group project (date and time and organization to be determined by the class) Participation in the Chambers Total Resource Campaign (TRC). Agree to represent the community, your business and the chamber in a professional manner at all times.
